Everyone who sleds in Wisconsin will need a trail pass this year!

- Effective July 1, 2015, snowmobile registration will cost \$30/3 years, a change from the \$30/2 years.
- All snowmobiles operating in Wisconsin will now be required to: display a Wisconsin Trail Pass (purchased separately from your snowmobile registration).
- A discounted annual (yearly) Wisconsin Trail Pass will be available to members who belong to both a snowmobile Club and the Association of Wisconsin Snowmobile Clubs (AWSC) for \$10 through the AWSC office in Deforest for each of your Wisconsin registered snowmobiles.
- Non-resident trail passes will now be \$50/yr.
- Non-residents can purchase a discounted Trail Pass if their snowmobile is registered in Wisconsin and they belong to a snowmobile Club and the AWSC.

So you can now understand why it is so important for you and your fellow snowmobilers to join a local snowmobile club. Our club has joined the AWSC and all of our paid members became a member of the AWSC and you should have received the WISCONSIN WSN SNOWMOBILE NEWS magazine if you were a club member last year. This is the publication of the AWSC and is published 7 times per year.

Your \$30 membership dues to the LLCK are divided into \$20 for your local club and \$10 for your AWSC dues. You will want to be a member of a club in 2018-20179so you will receive the discounted trail pass.

Please attend the annual meeting and make sure to send in your membership and dues when they are requested. AGAIN PLEASE NOTE: We intend to do trail work after the meeting. There is a need to brush the trails and remove overhead branches so the groomer can get through. Please bring appropriate equipment that maybe needed. Such as pole trimmers, saws pruners etc.

Also please pass the word on to anyone you know who sleds here or anywhere in Wisconsin the importance of becoming a member of a snowmobile club. Existing members will be mailed their membership renewal.
